What does Medicare Advantage cover?



Medicare Advantage (also known as Medicare Part C) is an alternative to Original Medicare, offered by private insurance companies approved by Medicare. These plans typically include a range of extra benefits beyond what Original Medicare covers. While specific benefits vary by plan, here are some general categories often included:



Dental Coverage

Routine cleanings, exams, fillings, and sometimes even dentures or more advanced dental procedures.



Vision Coverage

Eye exams, glasses, and contact lenses.



Prescription Drugs

Many Medicare Advantage plans include Part D prescription drug coverage, helping cover the cost of medications.

Over the counter

Allowances or discounts for health-related OTC products like pain relievers, vitamins, and first-aid supplies.



Transportation Services

Rides to and from medical appointments, which can be especially helpful for those with mobility or transportation challenges.



Fitness and Gym Memberships

Access to wellness programs and memberships like SilverSneakers or similar fitness programs to help maintain an active lifestyle.
